SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

The school recognizes the importance of providing students with an enjoyable and memorable high school experience, and promotes positive interaction through field trips and other social events. Students of the St Paul Prep Scholars program are regular high school students and have access to all classes, activities, and programming on their beautiful campus. The school enrolls about 800 students from grade 6-12 (our international students group counts 30 students, approximately) and the 40-acre campus is located in Maplewood, a suburb of St. Paul, MN, USA.

The Twin Cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul are located on opposite banks of the mighty Mississippi river. Together, the metropolitan area is home to approximately 2.8 million people. Residents enjoy the conveniences of urban city life in a beautiful, natural setting. Lakes, parks, and riverside trails are abundant throughout the metropolitan area. The climate in spring, summer and fall is generally mild. The winter can be cold and snowy, but residents enjoy outdoor activities such as skiing, snowboarding, ice-skating, snowshoeing and ice fishing during these months.

Great athletic programs are available;

in fact, students can choose from 23 varsity sports, including basketball. Also, the campus offers 36 clubs and activities for students.

International students who attend the school live with host families during their stay.

SCHOOL SYSTEM

The school is an AdvancED accredited High School. A wide variety of courses are offered in sciences, mathematics, language arts, foreign languages, social sciences, information technology, arts, and physical education. To provide students with additional academic challenge, the school offers several Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Besides the SPP Scholars program, the school also offers specific study programs such as a Technology Academy or an Entrepreneurial Academy.

SPP International Scholar's have access to two on-site support personnel: a Director of Enrollment, to assist with school programming and academics and a SPP International Scholars' Director, to assist with integration, communication and specific program related issues. Graduation is possible.
