HIGH SCHOOL ABROAD

Private school in France: Paris Boarding School

International students are placed in a selected private boarding school close to Paris. The partner school is located in very urban area, and benefit from proper sport facilities: international students quickly feel «at home» in this school.

French secondary education is divided into two tiers: the "collège" (Middle school) for the first four years (Grades 6-9); and the "lycée" (High school) for the last three years (Grades 10-12). Completion of secondary studies leads to the "baccalauréat". The school director makes the decision regarding grade and placement level for international students, taking into account the school organization, the students' transcripts and their French level.

Students will follow mandatory classes :

- French,
- English and one extra foreign language,
- mathematics,
- history/geography,
- physical education,
- physics/chemistry,
- earth and space science,
- economics ;
- and 3 electives in grade 11 (2 in grade 12) among a 7 to 12 choices.

ISSY-LES MOULINEAUX (Saint Nicolas)

Location: Issy-Les-Moulineaux, a town directly linked to Paris city center (15 minutes by foot from Latin Quarter!)

Size: 1500 students.

Boarding house 100 bedrooms-250 places for boys and girls. Shared rooms (1, 3 or 5 bedded rooms and shared bathrooms).

School Plus: Located close to Paris city center; activities at the dorm (theatre, dance, outings, movie, Football, Badminton, Table Tennis)



Location : Close to Paris

Boarding : Full board

Accommodation : Residence and Host family

Length : Fall term / Semester / Academic Year

Type : Private Boarding



International students live at the school boarding house with their schoolmates during weekdays (Monday to Friday) and stay with a volunteer host family on weekends and during bank and school holidays.

There is a strong community spirit in these schools and students are involved in school projects as much as French students.

Application deadline : March 31st for an arrival in August, October 31st for an arrival in January. Late application may be accepted, depending on availability and visa processing times.

Requirements : Students must be interviewed in their home country before being accepted on the program. A minimum of two years of French study (A2 level) and good academic results are required.
